### LOCAL SECRETARY'S CIRCULAR

Dear Member,

Hope you are in receipt of the First Circular from Prof. Sivadasan, General Secretary, SIHC, intimating you that the 38th Session of the South Indian History Congress is being held under the auspices of the Department of History, University of Calicut, Tenhipalam, 673635-Kerala on 28th, 29th and 30th of January 2018. It gives me immense pleasure in extending to you this cordial invitation on behalf of Prof. Dr.K Muhammed Basheer, Hon'ble Vice-Chancellor, University of Calicut, and also on my personal behalf, to participate in the 38th Annual Session of South Indian History Congress.

#### **Calicut**

Calicut (Kozhikode) is a coastal city in the northern side of Kerala. It was a significant spice trade center and is close to Kappad Beach, where Portuguese explorer Vasco da Gama landed in 1498. It was the headquarters of the famous dynasty of Zamorins, who fought against the Portuguese and Hyder Ali. Besides the Kappad Beach, central beach of Calicut, the light house, the Mananchira Square, the Mananchira tank, Baypore Port, Pazhassi Museum, and the Science and Technology Museum are the major tourist destinations of in and around the city. S.M. Street is a number one shopping centre not only in Kozhikode, but in Kerala. Waynad, the adjacent District is an international tourist spot with sites of historical and geographical importance. Edakkal Caves, Pookkode Lake, old Jain temples, and other hill stations with their hair-pin bends are attractive destinations for the visitors.

#### **University of Calicut**

The University of Calicut, accredited with 'A' grade by NAAC, is the largest University in Kerala. Established in the year 1968, the University of Calicut is celebrating its Golden Jubilee this year (1968-2018). University of Calicut is the second university to be set up in Kerala. Its jurisdiction extends to five districts- Wynad, Kozhikode, Malappuram, Palakkad and Trissur, serving about 3 lakh students every year. With 30 post graduate departments and 426 affiliated colleges it has become a beacon of hope and enlightenment for hundreds of thousands of young men and women in North Kerala.

#### **Department of History**

The Department of History at the University of Calicut is one of the leading departments devoted to historical research in South India. With well-structured syllabi and a decent library, the Department offers conducive research environment and vibrant ambience for students of Post-Graduate, M.Phil. and PhD programmes. Papers received on or before the due date will get precedence for presentation. More than one paper by a member shall not be admitted for presentation. The paper should be neatly computed in about 8 pages double spaced with end notes and two copies of the paper should be sent to the Local Secretary. End notes should be numbered consecutively throughout the paper and placed at the end. Most important is that the paper presenters while presenting their papers at the respective sections should hand over a soft copy in CD form to the concerned Sectional President. Those papers in English alone will be considered for inclusion in the Proceedings Volume.
