End notes should be numbered consecutively throughout the paper and placed at the end. Most important is that the paper presenters while presenting their papers at the respective sections should hand over a soft copy in CD form to the concerned Sectional President. Those papers in English alone will be considered for inclusion in the Proceedings Volume.
