Research Papers

Papers in all five sections (Political, Social, Economic, Cultural and Historiography and Maritime History) will be presented simultaneously. Scholars are requested to send their papers, soft copy to localsecretarysihcdgl2022@gmail.com, & sihcongresssecretary@gmail.com and hard copy [100 words abstract along with full text] on or before 10th August 2022 to The Local Secretary, 41st South Indian History Congress, Department of History, G.T.N Arts College (Autonomous) Dindigul, Tamil Nadu, 624005.

Papers received on or before the due date will get precedence for presentation. More than one paper by a member shall not be permitted for presentation. The paper should be neatly computed in about 8 pages double spaced with end notes and two copies of the paper should be sent to the Local Secretary. End notes should be numbered consecutively throughout the paper and placed at the end.

Research papers submitted to Congress shall strictly follow the style manual published on the website of the SIHC. To maintain the standard of our Proceedings, the Executive Committee has decided to apply the 'Plagiarism Check' to select papers for publication.

Most important is that the paper presenters while presenting their papers at the respective sections should hand over a soft copy in CD form to the concerned Sectional President. Those papers in English alone will be considered for inclusion in the Proceedings Volume.

Best Paper Award

The South Indian History Congress has instituted 'Kasthuri Misro Memorial Young Historian Award' for the best paper presented in all the five sections by scholars below the age of 45 (forty-five). Those who wish to consider their paper for the Award may send their papers as hard copies (Registered Post) with CD to the General Secretary, SIHC on or before 31 July 2022. Age proof also may attach to the hard copy.
