- Research Paper (in Word format only)

All are requested to register their participation through the online portal in advance. This will ensure a more convenient and well-organized experience for all participants. There will be facility to do spot registration and this can be done only through the registration portal.

Research Papers

Papers in all five sections

- Political
- Social
- Economic
- Cultural
- Historiography and Maritime History will be presented simultaneously.

Papers received on or before the due date will be given precedence for presentation. A member shall not be permitted to present more than one paper. The paper should be neatly typed, approximately 8 pages in length, double-spaced, with endnotes in Word format. Endnotes

should be numbered consecutively throughout the paper and placed at the end. Only papers in English will be considered for inclusion in the Proceedings Volume. The research paper in Word format is to be uploaded to the registration portal before the session.

Research papers submitted to the Congress shall strictly follow the style manual published on the SIHC website. To maintain the standard of our Proceedings, the Executive Committee has decided to apply a 'Plagiarism Check' to all papers before selecting them for publication.

Best Paper Awards

The South Indian History Congress has instituted the following Best Paper Awards.

1. **Kasturi Misra Memorial Young Historian Award** (For the best paper presented in all the five sections by scholars below the age of 45 -forty- five)
2. **Prof. Peddarapu Chenna Reddy & Dr. Subhashini Best Paper Award** (For the best paper in Social History Section, without any age restriction) and
3. **Dr. P. Balagurusamy and Mrs. R. Uma Best Paper Award** (For the best paper presented in all the five sections, without any age restriction)

Papers by the same scholars will not be considered for more than one Award.
